Michael L. Keough Named Catholic Foundation of North Georgia Director Emeritus

On November 29, the Catholic Foundation Board of Directors voted unanimously to honor former Chair of the Board Michael L. Keough with the title of Director Emeritus.

The title of Director Emeritus is bestowed by the Board of Directors to former board members who have shown exceptional dedication to the Catholic Foundation and its mission. Keough served on the Board of Directors from 2007 to 2017 and as the Chair of the Board, a position that also serves as the Chair of the Executive Committee, from 2010-2012.

During his entire tenure on the board, including while serving as Chair of the Board and Chair of the Executive Committee, Keough also simultaneously served on the Finance and Investment Committee and the Grants Committee. After his Board terms ended, he has continued to remain an active member of the Grants Committee.

Keough began an endowment fund to support the operations of the Catholic Foundation into the future and has worked hard to ensure its growth. In addition, Keough is a strong ambassador for the mission of the Foundation. He actively promotes the services of the Foundation and the ways the Foundation can assist in Catholic philanthropic giving.
