## **Catholic Foundation of North Georgia Announces Spring 2022 Catholic Community Grant Awards**

The Catholic Foundation of North Georgia issued 15 grants totaling \$100,000 for the 2022 competitive spring grant cycle for Catholic Community Grants.

The Catholic Foundation's Board of Directors awarded and approved 15 Catholic Community Grants for the spring grants cycle, which is open to Catholic schools. Funding for these grants is provided by the Conrads Family Education Fund, which supports Catholic schools located in the Archdiocese of Atlanta.

The Catholic Foundation attracts, professionally manages, and invests gifts to support the current and long-term financial needs of parishes, schools, charities, and other ministries. Through the stewardship and growth of the funds, grants are made to support the nonprofits, parishes, and schools serving the general community within the boundaries of the Archdiocese of Atlanta.

**Christ the King School, Atlanta: \$5,000** to help purchase new Chromebooks for the fifth grade to replace outdated Surface Pros.

**Holy Redeemer Catholic School, Johns Creek: \$8,000** to replace flooring in the bathrooms that are used by all school students and the parish religious education program.

**Immaculate Heart of Mary Catholic School, Atlanta: \$1,000** to purchase a storage unit for the new Pre-Kindergarten program.

**Monsignor Donovan Catholic High School, Athens: \$7,500** to purchase a gently used bus to help expand transportation services to and from school for students.

**Notre Dame Academy, Duluth: \$7,500** to replace a broken electronic sign with a new unit to provide updated communication with families.

**Our Lady of Mercy High School, Fayetteville: \$10,000** to support technology enhancements to the Fine Arts Program that will benefit the entire student body. *This grant will benefit St. Mary's Academy opening this fall.*

**Our Lady of the Assumption Catholic School, Brookhaven: \$5,800** to help fund educational reading software and a teaching aide for the inclusion program.

**Pinecrest Academy, Cumming: \$5,000** to complete the foundational phase of painting in the common gathering spaces of the school for the 30 year anniversary.

**St. Catherine of Siena Catholic School, Kennesaw: \$10,000** to replace old teacher laptops and purchase new materials for STEM Enrichment and PE classes.

**St. John the Evangelist Catholic School, Hapeville: \$7,700** to purchase and install water bottle filling stations to replace the existing water fountains.

**St. Joseph Catholic School, Athens: \$5,000** to purchase Catholic Family Crate resources to be used in the classroom and at home for Advent and Lent to connect experiences in our faith at home and school.

**St. Mary's Catholic School, Rome: \$5,000** to purchase new chairs for the conference room and administrative offices and new furniture for the entrance lobby.

**St. Peter Claver Regional Catholic School, Decatur: \$6,000** to help install a state-of-the art SMARTLAB from Creative Learning Systems.

**St. Pius X Catholic High School, Atlanta: \$10,000** to purchase and install automatic gates and updated fencing to help improve security on campus and reduce staff hours needed to manage the current gates.

**St. Thomas More Catholic School, Decatur: \$6,500** to purchase furniture for a new PreK-4 classroom beginning in the 2022-2023 school year.

## How to Apply for the Fall Grants Program

The Foundation accepts grant applications and makes grant awards twice a year. The next grant cycle opens August 1.

**Parishes:** Online applications open August 1, 2022, at [cfnga.org/grants](https://cfnga.org/grants) for Catholic Community Grants and Parish Enrichment Grants. The deadline is 5 PM on Wednesday, August 31.

**Nonprofits:** Online applications open August 1, 2022, at [cfnga.org/grants](https://cfnga.org/grants) for Catholic Community Grants. The deadline is 5 PM on Wednesday, August 31.

**Schools:** Applications are not accepted in the fall cycle. Schools may submit applications in the next spring grant cycle.

Applications must be completed through the online portal. Only one application per organization or archdiocesan department may be submitted. Parishes may submit one

application for a Parish Enrichment Grant and one for a Catholic Community Grant but both applications must be for different projects.
