Catholic Foundation of North Georgia Announces Spring 2023 Catholic Community Grant Awards

The Catholic Foundation's Board of Directors awarded and approved 18 Catholic Community Grants totaling \$115,400 for the spring grants cycle, which is open to Catholic schools. Funding for these grants is provided by the Conrads Family Education Fund, which supports Catholic schools located in the Archdiocese of Atlanta, as well as one of our donor advised funds during this grant cycle.

The Catholic Foundation attracts, professionally manages, and invests gifts to support the current and long-term financial needs of parishes, schools, charities, and other ministries. Through the stewardship and growth of the funds, grants are made to support the nonprofits, parishes, and schools serving the general community within the boundaries of the Archdiocese of Atlanta.

Blessed Trinity Catholic High School, Roswell: \$10,000 to purchase 72 e-readers for English classes.

Christ the King School, Atlanta: \$5,400 to purchase decodable reader books.

Cristo Rey Atlanta Jesuit High School, Atlanta: \$3,500 to purchase internet access points to provide connectivity and faster internet to all students and teachers in every classroom.

Holy Redeemer Catholic School, Johns Creek: \$4,500 to purchase folding stage extensions for school performances and ceremonies.

Immaculate Heart of Mary Catholic School, Atlanta: \$7,500 to help fund the renovation improvements to the school entrance.

Monsignor Donovan Catholic High School, Athens: \$9,500 to fund updates to the computer lab and purchase textbooks and other resources for new STEM courses.

Notre Dame Academy, Duluth: \$3,500 to purchase new Pre-K classroom furniture.

Queen of Angels Catholic School, Roswell: \$6,000 to fund equipment for the STREAM Lab.

St. Catherine of Siena Catholic School, Kennesaw: \$9,500 to purchase TCI Interactive K-8 Science Curriculum.

St. John the Evangelist Catholic School, Hapeville: \$6,500 to resurface the existing outdoor basketball court.

St. Joseph Catholic Parish School, Athens: \$5,500 to purchase and install a swing set for the new playground and playscape.

St. Joseph Catholic School, Marietta: \$6,500 to upgrade technology transitioning to a more efficient and educationally aligned platform.

St. Jude the Apostle Catholic School, Atlanta: \$3,500 to implement the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd faith formation program for the new Pre-K4 program.

St. Mary's Academy, Fayetteville: \$6,500 to make playground improvements to encourage more active recess and after school programs.

St. Mary's Catholic School, Rome: \$5,000 to purchase new desk chairs for our teachers.

St. Peter Claver Regional Catholic School, Decatur: \$11,000 to help replace an HVAC roof top unit (RTU).

St. Pius X Catholic High School, Atlanta: \$5,500 to build restrooms in the baseball field stand building.

St. Thomas More Catholic School, Decatur: \$6,000 to purchase new laptops for teachers.
