Catholic Foundation of North Georgia Announces Spring 2023 Parish Enrichment Grant Awards

The Catholic Foundation's Pastors Advisory Council made the following award recommendations for the grants to the Foundation's Board for approval. 21 grants totalling \$21,000 were awarded. These grants of \$1,000 each help meet needs that the pastor of a church has identified as meaningful. Funding for these grants is provided by the Reverend Monsignor Edward J. Dillon Fund (formerly called the General Fund).

Through the stewardship and growth of the funds, grants are made to support the nonprofits, parishes, and schools serving the general community within the boundaries of the Archdiocese of Atlanta.

Cathedral of Christ the King, Atlanta to train Hispanic catechist leaders.

Catholic Church of the Transfiguration, Marietta for a portable keyboard to provide intimate experience around sanctuary/altar area with smaller groups and to use for outdoor masses.

Catholic Church of St. Ann, Marietta to fund monthly family faith events for parishioners with children ages 3-18.

Corpus Christi Catholic Church, Stone Mountain to pay registration fees for 10 students to attend the Life Teen Steubenville Conference.

Holy Family Catholic Church, Marietta to fund fees for adults attending the overnight Confirmation retreat.

St. Andrew Catholic Church, Roswell to purchase additional TVs for Faith Formation classrooms of the parish.

St. Bernadette Catholic Church, Cedartown to purchase tables for the religious education classrooms.

St. Brigid Catholic Church, Johns Creek to host an adaptive field day for individuals with disabilities.

St. Clare of Assisi Catholic Church, Acworth to assist with the purchase of the first organ.

St. Gabriel Catholic Church, Fayetteville to update the religious education classrooms with saints, Catholic icons, etc. to expose students and adults to the richness of the Catholic faith.

St. Joseph Catholic Church, Athens to support the Gianna's Hope Ministry, a ministry helping families that have experienced miscarriage or infant loss in the Athens area.

St. Lawrence Catholic Church, Lawrenceville to assist with faith formation needs, including supplies for parent-child projects to build a Catholic legacy for the family.

St. Mary, Mother of God, Jackson for Smart TVs, accessories for classrooms, and text books for students and teachers for religious education.

St. Mary's Catholic Church, Rome for liturgical and faith formation support for the parish's Trion, GA outreach mission, El Señor es Mi Pastor.

St. Mary's Catholic Mission, Elberton to enhance the entrance foyer to the church and to enhance the use of the small multi-purpose room.

St. Monica Catholic Church, Duluth to allow our high school students to travel to and from the fall retreat together safely.

St. Peter's Catholic Church, LaGrange to purchase two TVs to be used for adult faith formation classes, as well as give media access to all Religious Education classes from PreK to highschool.

St. Philip Benizi Catholic Church, Jonesboro to purchase chairs for The Forum, a multipurposed room to be used for education, community meetings, and prayer groups and services.

St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic Church, Roswell to defray the cost of required digital programming for Life Teen pre- and post-Confirmation education.

St. Vincent de Paul Catholic Church, Dallas to continue to collect and distribute personal items for the homeless and needy in the area by students in the religious education program and parishioners.

Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic Church, Decatur to support the annual Vacation Bible School which enables promoting and stimulating in the youth the importance of a strong, grounded Catholic faith.
