Catholic Foundation of North Georgia Announces Fall 2023 Parish Enrichment Grant Awards

The Catholic Foundation's Pastors Advisory Council made the following award recommendations for the grants to the Foundation's Board for approval. Twenty grants totaling \$20,000 were awarded. These grants of \$1,000 each help meet needs that the pastor of a church has identified as meaningful. Funding for these grants is provided by the Reverend Monsignor Edward J. Dillon Fund (formerly called the General Fund).

Corpus Christi Catholic Church, Stone Mountain to purchase a surge protector and cables for the sound system.

Good Samaritan Catholic Church, Ellijay to purchase bibles for the Parish School of Religion program.

Holy Name of Jesus Chinese Catholic Mission, Norcross to help fund Family & Friends Day expenses, including activities, supplies, food, and drink.
